The Swinging Hamburg City Jazz Walk

It was again one of the biggest and most ambitious jazz events of the 'Free City of Hamburg' – the 'Swinging Hamburg City Jazz Walk'. Twelve top bands from Hamburg played on the 12 August, from 10.30am to 6.30pm, at 12 venues. The venues were around the Alster, Hamburg's beautiful inland waterway. Jazz fans had been invited, via NDR Radio, posters and flyers, to travel to the venues and listen to their favourite bands: the Cotton Club Big Band, Hot Shots, Skiffle Track, Arnim Silvar's Dream Band, Riverside Jazz Connection, Chill @ Bossa, Shreveport Rhythm, Jazz-O-Maniacs, Les Enfants du Jazz, Swing Combination, Jailhouse Jazzmen, and Münster's Old Merry Tale Jazz Band.

In brilliant weather thousands of music lovers came from far and wide – walkers and cyclists included. All stayed until the last notes died away, and then went on to the next band, elated. A good opportunity, with free admission, to hear the variety of

Classic and traditional jazz in the city. It was again, just like last year, an incredibly happy day. All – jazz fans, musicians and

organisers – agreed that next year it would, once again, do the 'Swinging Hamburg City Jazz Walk'. ■



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
